 - D.** **LUKE 1:37** – Nothing is impossible with God.
 - E.** **IS. 53:5** – “By His stripes we are healed.”
 - F.** **IS. 59:1** – God hears and answers prayer.
 - G.** **ROM. 10:17** – We all have faith that can increase.
- 2.** What didn’t need corrected.
 - A.** How she saw herself. “Walking with shoes on!”
 - B.** **PR. 29:18** – God sees us whole. God gave Abraham visual aid. When in doubt, look at the stars and sand.
 - C.** Her belief that God could heal her even when man says nothing can be done. “You will never be different than you are now!”
- 3.** What needed corrected.
 - A.** Her love walk.
 - B.** Her doubt, fear and unbelief. **MK. 9:23-24**
 - C.** There was no contact of faith even though she believed.
- 4.** The correction.
 - A.** One can believe without receiving – glass of water illustration.
 - B.** One must accept healing in a definite way as we received Christ.

- 5.** The results.
 - A.** Jesus touched her and made her whole after she touched Him with her faith.
 - B.** She said she would walk out of that hospital with her shoes on and she got what she said.
