REVIEW:

Last time we discussed the divine exchange. How Christ was made sin to make us righteous, was rejected to make us accepted, suffered sorrow to give us unspeakable joy, and was made a curse so we could be blessed.

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Our objective is to unveil the work of Christ in redemption, and help us enter His finished work by faith.

THREE PHASES OF CHRIST’S WORK – JOHN 17:4-5, 19:30

1. Deal with everything pertaining to the first covenant.
 - A. Fulfill the Abrahamic covenant. **GENESIS 17:1-4, HEBREWS 8:6**
 - B. Fulfill and set aside the law, priesthood and sacrifices.
 - Law – **GALATIANS 3:10-14**
 - Priesthood – **HEBREWS 7:11-14 (NLT)**
 - Sacrifices – **HEBREWS 10:1, 12-14** “These are finished”
2. His work as our substitute.
 - A. God’s law required one of two things: Perfect obedience, or perfect atonement. **JAMES 2:10 (CEV), ISAIAH 64:6 (AMPC)** – We can’t keep the law, our blood can’t atone for our sin.
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3. His ministry today. **HEBREWS 1:3, ROMANS 8:34**
 - A. High Priest, Mediator, Advocate, Intercessor, Surety. These are ongoing.
 - B. **ROMANS 3:23-26** Jesus - our justifier!

ENTERING HIS REST BY FAITH – HEBREWS 3:18-4:3

1. The promised land of rest. **DEUTERONOMY 6:10-11 (NLT)**
 - A. They had nothing to do with the blessings.
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 - C. **COLOSINIANS 2:10-17** - Jesus is our Sabbath. The Sabbath is a person, not a day.

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We don’t complete a completed work or finish a finished work. **EPHESIANS 2:8-10** – By faith, we become the workmanship He worked to produce.
