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CONTINUE: HEBREWS 11:24-28

THE FAITH AND OBEDIENCE OF MOSES

1. Refused to be called the Pharaoh's grandson.
2. Chose to suffer affliction than to enjoy sin's pleasures.
3. Esteemed reproach for Christ more valuable than Egypt's treasures.
4. Respected God's rewards far above any earthly reward.
5. By faith he forsook Egypt, endured, kept the Passover, and crossed the Red Sea on dry land.

NUMBERS 20:8-12 (NIV)

THE UNBELIEF AND DISOBEDIENCE OF MOSES

1. Pride. **V10** Moses took credit for the miracle. He failed to attribute it to God. God resists the proud.
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 - A. **EXODUS 17:6** – Water came out after the first strike. This time it didn't, so he hit it again.
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 - A. **LUKE 17:5-6** – Jesus taught that faith works by saying.
4. Publicly dishonoring God. **V12b** Remember how David gave God's enemies an opportunity to speak against Him (**2 SAMUEL 12:14**) and was judged by God for his sin? Moses publicly dishonored God and was judged for it.
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 - A. The rock being struck once the first time was a type of the crucifixion of Christ. Striking the rock twice was like crucifying Christ a second time. **1 CORINTHIANS 10:4**
 - B. **HEBREWS 7:27, 9:12,28, 10:11-14**

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3. Unbelief. **V12a** Moses had faith to strike the rock, but not to speak to the rock. God could've been teaching Moses the power of the tongue, and the Law of Faith. **MARK 11:23**
 - A. **LUKE 17:5-6** – Jesus taught that faith works by saying.
4. Publicly dishonoring God. **V12b** Remember how David gave God's enemies an opportunity to speak against Him (**2 SAMUEL 12:14**) and was judged by God for his sin? Moses publicly dishonored God and was judged for it.
5. Misrepresenting the sacrifice of Christ. **V11**
 - A. The rock being struck once the first time was a type of the crucifixion of Christ. Striking the rock twice was like crucifying Christ a second time. **1 CORINTHIANS 10:4**
 - B. **HEBREWS 7:27, 9:12,28, 10:11-14**

PERSONAL APPLICATION

 - A. It's easy to dishonor and mischaracterize Him if we don't know His Word and character. **1 JOHN 1:5**
5. Focus on the sacrifice of Christ and His finished work.
 - A. Jesus already paid the price for everything we need, and He doesn't have to die again for us to receive.

In Christ, God has done His part in providing for our every need. Now, we must do our part: Believe to see the glory. Show mercy to receive mercy. Give and it will be given to us.

1. Pride. **V10** Moses took credit for the miracle. He failed to attribute it to God. God resists the proud.
2. Disobedience. **V11** Like Adam and Eve, he disobeyed a direct command of the Lord. Instead of speaking to the rock, he struck it twice.
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
