REVIEW:

We are living in the time of the Gentiles, or harvest time. It's coming to a close, the trumpet is about to sound, the church is about to be raptured, Jewish time is about to resume, tribulation will begin, Armageddon will end it, and Christ's 1000-year reign will start. Our duty now is to preach the Gospel.

CONTINUE: - ACTS 20:24-28

Paul's advice to Pastors was to preach the Gospel and feed the church He bought with His Own Blood. A Pastors primary duty is to feed the sheep good news. To teach New Testament truth and what Jesus accomplished in redemption. Paul said because he did this, he was pure from the blood of all men.

PAUL IN ACTION – ACTS 14:7-10

- Paul did three things: Preached, perceived and gave a command. The man did three things: Listened, believed and acted. What was Paul's message? Who taught him the Gospel? Jesus taught him the Gospel. Since the message produced faith to be healed, Paul had to preach about healing being in the atonement and part of our redemptive package.
- **GALATIANS 3:13-14** – To redeem means to regain possession of something in exchange for a payment. The curse of the law is found in **DEUTERONOMY 28:15, 58-61** – Jesus taught him He redeemed us from every sickness known or unknown to man.
- **ISAIAH 53:1-5 (CSB) (Christian Standard Bible)** – He taught Paul the price He paid to provide health. **ROMANS 10:14-17** – confirms it.

PETER'S CONFIRMATION – 1 PETER 2:24

- Jesus paid the price for our spiritual and physical well-being. Healed is iaomai. It's used 25 times, always in connection with physical healing. **LUKE 6:17, MARK 5:29**

MATTHEW'S CONFIRMATION – MATTHEW 8:16-17

Matthew states that Jesus healed the sick in fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy. What more proof does one need?

WHICH IS HARDER? – LUKE 5:17-26

The critics of Jesus didn't deny He could heal the sick, they denied He had power to forgive sins. Today, the church knows that sin can be forgiven, but stumbles over the fact that healing has been provided in redemption.
