1. Our level of consecration. **MATTHEW 3:13-17**
 - A. There's power in consecration to principle. John G. Lake's Eight Principles of Consecration. Adventures in God, pages 121-125 Jesus was committed to fulfilling all righteousness.
2. Our level of thirst and hunger. **JOHN 7:37-39**
 - A. There must be an inflow before there can be an out flow.
 - B. David was thirsty and hungry for God. **PSALMS 63:1-2, 42:1-2**
3. Our level of faith. **GALATIANS 3:1-5**
 - A. By faith we receive the source of power. **ACTS 10:38**, Jesus did. He's our source of limitless power, an everlasting fountain of power who dwells within.
 - B. By faith we unleash the power of the Spirit. Many times when facing the impossible, we wait for God to do something instead of using our faith to unleash His power as in **MARK 5:25-34**.
4. Our level of commitment to prayer and praise. **ACTS 16:25-26** Adventures in God, pages 27-31
 - A. Through prayer and praise we generate miracle power and bring God on the scene as did Paul and Silas. **JAMES 5:16 (AMPC)**
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 - A. How we react when challenged is critical. We either activate or short circuit God's power by how we respond to circumstances. **PHILIPPIANS 1:28 (AMPC)**
 - B. We must know that the light in us is greater than the darkness we face in this world. When light enters a room, darkness flees. Remember the fiery furnace?
7. Our level of following love, and desire for spiritual gifts. **1 CORINTHIANS 14:1**
 - A. Love is the foundation for all we do. Without it, power can lead to pride. Pride produced sin's power, but love defeated both.
 - B. We are to be passionate about spiritual gifts.
