REVIEW: JOHN 10:10

- Jesus came to give us a full life spiritually, emotionally and physically.
- Satan comes to destroy us spiritually, emotionally and physically.
- His constant challenges can cause us to faint in our minds.
- Strength to overcome is found in God. **ISAIAH 40:28-31**
- We can be “I can” or “I can’t” receptacles.

CONTINUE: PHILIPPIANS 2:14-16 (NLT)

Complaining can prevent us from experiencing the fulness of life. God doesn't take it lightly. It opens the door to judgement.

THE RIGHT ATTITUDE

NUMBERS 13:30

- Caleb stilled the people: To still means to silence, calm down or subdue. Remember **PSALMS 46:10** there's something to know when the devil, world and flesh are ganging up on us and making so much negative noise that we see no way to overcome.
- "We are well able" – Able means having the power, skill, means, resources or power to accomplish something. Caleb knew God was on their side and would enable them to succeed.

NUMBERS 14:8

- "God will bring us in, God will give it to us." We say "God has brought us in, He has given us the fulness of life in Christ."
- "Only rebel not." – To rebel means to oppose, resist or go against God.
- "Neither fear ye the people." – Their defense is departed. Their ability to protect themselves isn't just minimized, it's gone.
- "The Lord is with us." **ROMANS 8:31**

NUMBERS 14:11

- "How long" God asks two questions: Provoke means to deliberately annoy or make angry; believe means to accept what was said is true. It means to take God at His Word and trust Him to do what He said.
- "Signs." – An object, event or entity that indicates something or verifies something. **ISAIAH 38:8**
