- The law of faith can be interrupted when the conditions aren't met.
- Faith involves the believer's heart and mouth being in sync.

ROMANS 12:1-3

We all begin with saving faith that comes to us when we hear the Gospel.

ROMANS 10:13-17

There are three key components to faith: Hearing, believing and acting. The primary action of faith being speaking.

MARK 5:25-34

She heard, she believed, she said and she acted out her faith. Her faith was based on what she heard. She heard that those who touch Jesus' garment are healed. She kept saying what she believed. Even when challenged by the crowd she refused to abort her faith project. The results came as a result of her faith according to Jesus.

MARK 7:24-30

The woman was not entitled to the benefits of the Abrahamic covenant, she had no rights to healing, deliverance or any other covenant rights. She said from her heart what she believed. Even dogs have some rights. Jesus said the demon was gone because of what she said.

1 TIMOTHY 6:12

Faith is a fight. Faith doesn't mean we effortlessly glide through life without any struggles along the way. The Word for fight is where we get our word agony from. It's a word that pictures wrestlers in a wrestling match struggling to overcome his opponent.

- The flesh that resists the will of God.
- The mind that struggles with thoughts and imaginations.
- Circumstances that contradict God's Word.
- People who oppose us.
- The devil himself who opposes every step of faith we take.

The word good in context means give your best effort as you stand against your opponents. The fact Paul uses fight again means to give complete concentration and stay totally focused. It means to be totally committed to victory. It means to be determined to overcome every obstacle along the way.

The word profess is the same word confess, faith involves a confession of what we believe.

MATTHEW 10:32, HEBREWS 3:1

1 SAMUEL 17:44-47

David models what it means to confess our faith. David believed in his heart that what he said with his mouth would come to pass. No one told him what to say. His confession was birthed out of a close walk with God. It came from intimacy with God as he communed with Him as a young shepherd boy.

- David used the Name of the Lord of Hosts: Lord over earthly and heavenly armies. It's used 235 times, meaning the Lord is my defense.
