ROMANS 1:16-17, HEBREWS 4:1-2

The gospel is the power of God that transforms lives, but it benefits only those who mix faith with it.

MARK 11:22-23

Jesus taught on faith. The heart and mouth must be in sync. One must believe from the heart in his words.

2 CORINTHIANS 4:13

Faith involves believing and speaking. Paul saw the resurrected Christ and had a change of heart. He was persecuted beyond words, yet his heart remained fixed.

PSALMS 116:11

Haste means too quickly without thinking. We're to be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath.

JOB 6:24-25, 7:11-16

PSALMS 19:14

Acceptable means satisfactory, adequate, conforming. **PSALMS 91:1-2** "I will say" is the secret place of the most high. God wants us to say it.

PSALMS 96:10

Say it among the heathen.

PSALMS 107:1-2

God's Word teaches us to talk right. **PSALMS 118:2-4** God wants us to say it, from the heart.

PSALMS 35:27-28

Say it continually "let the Lord be magnified" speak of God's righteousness and praise, all day long.
