## TITUS 2:11-14

- 1.) Paul knew what Titus was up against (1:12).
- 2.) Titus was close to Paul (1:4).
- 3.) His assignment was to set things in order (1:5).
- 4.) His message was the kindness and love of God (3:1-5).
- 5.) There was a need for sound doctrine (1:10-11).
- 6.) Order in the Church (1:5-9).
- 7.) Good works (1:16, 2:7-8).

### Glorious Grace for Daily Living

- 1.) His assignment was to take liars, evil beasts, and lazy gluttons, and guide them into good works, positive speech, and sound doctrine.
- 2.) Grace touches all three tenses.
  - A.) Past – The birth of Christ.
  - B.) Present – How to live now.
  - C.) Future – when Christ returns.
- 3.) Grace teaches us how to please God by:
  - A.) Denying ungodliness or rejecting sin.
  - B.) Living soberly or self-controlled lives.
  - C.) Respecting others through righteous living.
  - D.) Reverencing God with disciplined devotion.
- 4.) “Looking For” means persistent expectation:
  - A.) He’s coming again to set up His kingdom.
  - B.) He’s coming for redeemed people, purified for Himself and zealous for good works while waiting His return.
- 5.) Jesus is the great God and Savior who came into the world to save us and is coming again to glorify us (**TITUS 1:11-14 NIV**).
