- 2.) By following God's instructions (Naaman). IS. 26:3
- 3.) By the laying on of hands (MK. 16:18).
- 4.) By anointing with oil (JAMES 5:14-15).
- 5.) By the gifts of the Spirit (1 COR. 12).
- 6.) By taking God's Word as medicine (PR. 4:20-22).
- 7.) By the quickening of the Spirit (ROM. 8:11).
- 8.) By diligently seeking the Healer (HEB. 11:6).
