Keys

- Desire. Spiritual hunger attracts God's presence. PS. 63:1-2 Moses also longed to see God's glory.
- **2.)** Humility. God gives grace to the humble. He mantles the lowly with His glory. Remember Elisha?
- **3.)** Reverence and Godly fear. **ACTS 5:11-12** When reverential fear manifested, demonstrations of God's power occurred.
- 4.) Honor. To honor means to value, highly esteem, to respect.
 1 SAM. 2:30 God replaced His unconditional promise with a conditional one because of sin.
- **5.)** Consecration and unity. **2 CHRON. 5:11-13** This attracted God's glory to the point they couldn't stand.
- **6.)** Worship. By magnifying God's goodness and mercy, they attracted God's glory.
- 7.) Prayer. ACTS 10 Cornelius' prayer life and compassion attracted God's glory and caused the spirit to be poured out on his entire family.
