THE BLOOD THAT HEALS FEBRUARY 4, 2024

HEB. 12:22-24 NASB

Blood speaks: Abel's spoke of justice and vengeance. The Blood of Jesus speaks of better things than Abel's, including healing. Before considering the blood that heals, we'll consider some statements the Bible makes about blood (HEB. 9:12).

- 4,000 years before Jesus entered Heaven with His blood, Adam's high treason severed man's relationship with God and brought upheaval to every realm known to man.
- As far back as **GEN. 3:21**, God taught man that only by the sacrifice of innocent blood could He have any approach to God. Since then, no one can calculate how much animal blood was offered to protect man from God's wrath.
- **HEB. 10:4** Says animal blood can't take away sin. When Jesus offered His blood, it did what millions of gallons of animal blood could never do—obtain eternal redemption for us.

The Blood that Heals

Before His crucifixion, Jesus was beaten beyond reason (IS. 52:14 NIV). His blood was shed in the garden; the cat o' nine tails tore His flesh; the crown of thorns; the crucifixion; and the spear that pierced His side. IS. 53:3-5 AMPC, MT. 8:16-17 NLT, 1 PET. 2:24 NLT.

The Crown of Thorns

Has symbolism: **GEN. 3:17-18** It represents a crown of curses, as thorns and thistles were part of the curse on humanity. **GAL. 3:13-14** Jesus wore the crown that He would become for us.
