REVIEW – HEB. 12:24 NASB

- Three aspects: Facts, faith, and feelings.
- Facts form the foundation; faith rests on the foundation; feelings come last.
- Spiritual maturity involves moving from being feelings-driven, to being facts-driven.

CONTINUE – HEB. 11:6 Impossible means it can't be done.

- 1.) Fact. Something that's true. Two plus two is a fact that's always true. It's true if no one believes it's true or feels it's true. My believing it doesn't make it true. It's true globally!
 - A.) Jesus died for our sins and sicknesses is a fact.
- 2.) Faith. Perceives as fact what's not revealed to our senses. **HEB. 11:1-3 AMPC**. Faith deals with unseen things, **2 COR. 4:16-18 NKJV**.
 - A.) Our faith doesn't make God's facts true. They are true facts.
 - B.) Our faith in the facts makes them a reality.
 - C.) **ROM. 10:13-17** Faith comes by hearing the facts.
 - D.) The same is true with healing, **1 PET. 2:24**.
- 3.) Feelings. Our feelings can't be trusted. They're not dependable. They constantly change.
 - A.) **PS. 131:1-2 AMPC** To wean means to learn to manage without something we were dependent on.
 - B.) Cain had faith in his feelings, **GEN. 4:3-7 AMPC**. He ignored the facts and allowed his feelings to control his behavior.

The Blood that Heals – Facts GAL. 3:13-14, 29

- 1.) Who? What? How? When? Why?
 - A.) Who? Christ **REV. 5:9**
 - B.) What? Redeemed us from the curse of the law.
 - C.) How? By being made a curse for us.
 - D.) When? When He hung on the tree.
 - E.) Why? So, Gentiles could receive Abraham's blessings and the promise of the Spirit through faith.
- 2.) The Curse of the Law. **DEUT. 28:58-61**
 - A.) Christ redeemed us from every sickness: known, unknown; named, unnamed; written, unwritten.
 - B.) **DEUT. 28:1-8 NKJV**

3.) Abraham and his seed. GAL. 3:16, 29

- A.)** Christ was present when God made the covenant with Abraham. Why? Because He represented us. Christ didn't need eternal life, health, righteousness, deliverance, protection, or success. Abraham did and so would Abraham's seed!
- B.) GEN. 12:2-3 NKJV** Blessed means to endue with power for success, longevity, and prosperity.
- C.) HEB. 2:16 NKJV** Aid, assistance, and help.
- D.) LUKE 13:16 NKJV** Deliverance and healing.
- E.) LUKE 19:5-10** Salvation.

Conclusion:

The facts are: Jesus' blood redeemed us from the curse of the law and gives us access to the blessings of Abraham. We are Abraham's seed and heirs according to the promise. These facts are true no matter what anyone believes. They're established facts, just as $2 + 2 = 4$!
