- Blood has a voice. Abel's spoke of justice, Jesus' speaks of redemption.
- Facts, faith, and feelings are three aspects of our walk with God.
- The fight of faith involves facts vs feelings, spirit vs flesh.
- Christ redeemed us from the law's curse (GAL. 3:13-14, 29; DEUT. 28:58-61).

CONTINUE:

• GAL. 3:16, 29 Christ was present when God made the covenant with Abraham. Why? Because He represented us. He didn't need life, righteousness, health, deliverance, protection, or anything else. Abraham and his seed did. We are Abraham's seed through Christ.

The Blessings of Abraham

- **DEUT. 28:1-14 NKJV** Christ took the curse and left us the blessings.
- **GEN. 12:2-3 NKJV** Blessed means to endue with power for success, longevity, and prosperity.
- HEB. 2:16 NKJV Aid, assistance, help.
- LUKE 13:16 NKJV Deliverance and healing.
- **LUKE 19:5-10** Salvation.

The Facts

The Blood of Jesus speaks of redemption, justification, sanctification, cleansing, deliverance, access, healing, covenant, royalty, and total salvation. We are Abraham's seed and heirs according to the promise. These facts are true no matter what anyone believes, just as 2 + 2 = 4.

The Blood Applied

- EX. 12:21-23 The blood of the Passover lamb had to be applied to the door posts and lintel of their houses. If not, death would strike the firstborn male. Hyssop was used to apply the blood.
- **REV. 12:11** Instead of hyssop, we use declarations, decrees, and words to apply the Blood of Jesus to our lives. The word of our testimony is our confession of faith in the facts of redemption provided by the Blood of Christ. We confess what His Blood purchased for us.

Our High Priest HEB. 3:1 NKJV

He's the High Priest of our confession (saying the same thing). We confess Him and He confesses us (MT. 10:32). ROM. 10:8-10 Notice the sequence--

Believe, confess, experience. **HEB. 4:14-16 NKJV** We hold fast to our confession knowing our great High Priest is compassionate and ever-ready to provide mercy and grace.

In Sync - MT. 15:8

The heart and mouth must be in sync. 2 COR. 4:13 We believe from the heart and speak with our lips. Jesus agrees, MK. 11:23

What do we confess? JER. 1:12 AMPC

We are to hold fast to our redemptive rights and privileges in Christ, and who we are in Him because of the New birth. We confess our faith in the facts pertaining to our redemption so they can become realities in our lives. **PR. 4:22**

- PS. 107:20 Jesus is the Word who came to heal and deliver us.
- 1 PET. 2:24 By your stripes, I am healed.
- ROM. 8:11 Your spirit is quickening my mortal body.
- EX. 23:25 Thank you for removing sickness from me.
- JER. 30:17 Thank you for restoring health to me.
- PS. 118:17 I will not die, but live, and declare God's works.
- PS. 103:1-5 Thank you for forgiving all my sins and healing all my diseases.
