

THE BLOOD THAT HEALS – 5
MARCH 3, 2024

LEV. 17:11

William Harvey was the first person to correctly describe the circulation of the blood. “It is the first to live, and the first to die, and the primary seat of the soul. It lives and is nourished of itself and by no other part of the body”. If the life of the flesh is in the blood, and Adam’s body had no life in it until God breathed into it, the blood must be the link between the physical matter and the spiritual. **ACTS 17:24-26** We all came from one blood supply. This means racism has no foundation.

Adam’s Blood (ROM. 5:12 NLT)

Adam’s sin contaminated man’s blood supply. The sinful nature that resided in his blood passed on from him, to every person born into the world. The voice of Adam’s blood speaks of death and judgment.

Animal Blood (HEB. 9:19-22 NLT)

Every Jew knew the importance of the blood. Their entire religious system was based on blood sacrifices. What they failed to understand is found in **HEBREWS 10:4**. Animal blood can’t remove sin.

Christ’s Blood (1 PET. 1:18-20 NLT)

Christ is called the last Adam and second man (**1 COR. 15:45-47 NLT**). He’s also called the seed of the woman, not of the man (**GAL. 4:4-5**). His blood was not contaminated with the first Adam’s sinful contaminants. He was the only man since the first Adam to be born with uncontaminated blood. His blood is precious because it’s sinless and qualifies to pay man’s ransom.

Flesh and Bones (LUKE 24:39)

Jesus came to Earth in a flesh, blood, and bone body. But flesh and blood can’t inherit the kingdom of God (**1 COR. 15:50**). Jesus is seated in Heaven in a flesh and bone body. Instead of blood flowing through His veins, God’s glory does.

Where’s the Blood? (HEB. 9:11-12 NKJV)

As our High Priest, Jesus offered His blood as the perfect Lamb of God, obtained redemption for us, and in return, He got back the glory He left behind to save us from eternal damnation (**REV. 5:9-10**). His blood is on the altar speaking of the Father’s right to give birth to those who call upon the Name of Jesus!

Confessions Based on the Blood

- 1.) **REV. 1:5** I'm forgiven, released from the penalty of sin, and cleansed from sin's guilt, stain, and shame.
- 2.) **EPH. 1:7** My sin debt is paid in full and I'm no longer under the jurisdiction of Satan's kingdom (**COL. 1:12-14**).
- 3.) **ROM. 5:9** God sees me just as if I never sinned.
- 4.) **COL. 1:20** I live in peace and harmony with God, totally reconciled.
- 5.) **HEB. 13:12 NLT** I'm not trying to be holy, I am holy.
- 6.) **JOHN 6:53-54** I have eternal life and I'm a partaker of God's divine nature (**2 PET. 1:4 NASB**).
- 7.) **HEB. 10:17-19 NLT** My sins are forgiven and forgotten and I have access to heaven's most holy place.
- 8.) **MT. 26:28** I have a guarantee that every covenant promise is "yes" and the "Amen" is spoken by me (**2 COR. 1:20 NIV**).
- 9.) **IS. 53:4-5 AMPC** The Father laid my sin, sickness, disease, and mental anguish on Jesus, and by His stripes, I am healed!
- 10.) **REV. 12:11** I am triumphant and victorious over everything and anything the enemy brings my way.

Conclusion

What can wash away our sin and empower us to live holy, faithful, victorious lives? Nothing but the Blood of Jesus.
