2 CHRON. 20:20-23

Spiritual warfare is real. Individually, as a nation, we're in a spiritual warfare. Thankfully, God has provided spiritual weapons for us. Praise and worship is one of them.

A Nation

Jehoshaphat calls a fast, God speaks, the praise team worships, victory is won. The victory belonged to God, the means through which God gave the victory was the praise team.

An Individual – ACTS 16:25-26

Through prayer and praise, God delivered them from destruction. God gave the victory, but the human means involved praise and worship.

A Demoniac MARK 5:1-7

The man went from crying and cutting, to worship at the feet of Jesus. Satan couldn't stop him from using his free will to run to Jesus for help. The word for worship means to prostrate oneself in homage; to reverence; to adore.

The Command PS. 95:1-7

David understood the power of praise and worship (PS. 34:1-4).

The Results

- A nation is spared.
- The enemy is confused, defeated, and overcome.
- Spiritual power is released.
- The light pushes back the darkness.
- To execute judgment (PS. 149:9).
