

HOLY GHOST FIRE

2 CHRON. 7:1-3

The Temple is built, Solomon prays, fire falls, sacrifices are consumed, and the glory fills the Temple.

LEV. 6:12-14

The fire is a supernatural fire. Wood represents human effort. The priests were to keep the fire burning and guard it, so it would never burn out. The fuel being the wood and the sacrifices.

LEV. 9:22-24

There were five offerings: Sin, Burnt, Trespass, Meal, and Peace. The Sin offering addressed man's sinful nature. The Trespass focused on specific violations of God's laws. The Burnt offering targeted the atonement for sin. The Meal offering was a voluntary expression of devotion to God, and the Peace offering expressed the need for fellowship with God and others.

HEB. 10:5-14

Jesus fulfilled all five sacrifices by the sacrifice of Himself. His one sacrifice perfects forever those who accept Him.

1 PET. 2:5, 9

Now, we are God's priests and His temple, We are to keep the fire burning so that the glory would continue to fill the house of God. We offer spiritual sacrifices through Christ, **HEB. 13:15-16.**

ACTS 2:1-4

The Temple was finished, the believers were in unity, in prayer and in obedience to the Lord's command to wait for the promise of the Father, **ACTS 1:4, 14.**

Acts 2:41-47

To keep the fire burning and the glory flowing, they stayed in the Word, in prayer, in unity and in praising God continually.

Conclusion: God provides the fire, but we must keep it burning by offering God our praises and surrendering our lives in devotion to Him and to others.
