THE HEALING WORD "A PERPETUAL DECREE" JUNE 25, 2025

PS. 107:17-21

Twenty-four years ago today, Andrew Thomas Anzevino was born at the Medical Center in Beaver. What should've been a joyful celebration, suddenly turned into a fierce fight for Andrew's survival. As I stood looking into the nursery, a team of medical personnel was doing what they could to discover why Andrew's face was blue. My mother-in-law tapped me on my shoulder and asked, "What's going to happen to Andrew?". It was then God sent me His Word saying, "Fear not, only believe." Those were the words that we clung to when fear tried to grip our hearts and get us to abort our fight of faith.

"I know people were talking to me and saying things that I could not comprehend. I couldn't cry, I could barely breathe. It felt like my chest was going to cave in. I kept thinking, this can't be happening. This isn't real. It was the worst feeling I ever had in my life. My emotions were raging within me, yet I clung to the words of God, "Fear not, only believe". I refused to give in to the fear that tried to grip my heart."

The Fight of Faith

1 TIM. 6:12 Faith is a fight with words. PR. 18:21 Death and life are in the power of the tongue. We knew the importance of our words and we were determined to make our words containers of life and not fearful declarations of doubt and unbelief (MK. 6:5-6).
