

PRAYING IN THE SPIRIT

2 THES. 1:11-12

The work of God is a work of faith with power. Faith comes by hearing, and power comes by the Spirit. **ACTS 1:8** When one is filled with the Spirit, power to witness is imparted to him, as it was on the day Pentecost. **ACTS 2:38-39** This work of the Spirit is for all Believers.

1 COR. 14:14-15 AMP

Praying in the Spirit involves our spirit and the Spirit of God. The mind is not involved. Our spirit, by the Holy Spirit, prays with other tongues.

- There are three manifestations of Tongues: Sign, ministry, and devotional Tongues.

Paul encouraged believers to speak in Tongues in their own devotional prayer lives.

1 COR. 14:2 AMPC Divine secrets can be prayed out.

1 COR. 14:4 AMPC Praying in Tongues is a spiritual exercise that builds us up (**JUDE 20**).

ACTS 10:44-46 AMPC Tongues is a way to extol and magnify God, just as it was done on the day of Pentecost.

1 COR. 14:16-19 AMPC Tongues is a way to give thanks to God well and nobly; but publicly, Tongues doesn't edify without interpretation.

ROM. 8:26-27 NLT The Spirit helps us pray out the will of God.

CONCLUSION: Praying in the Spirit, with other Tongues, is the doorway into the supernatural. The more we pray in the Spirit, the more we position ourselves to experience the other Gifts of the Spirit.

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
