JOSH. 24:15

Throughout history many have encountered supernatural encounters with God that transformed their lives and ignited within them a passion to serve God.

- 1. Noah's encounter moved him to build an ark by faith. (1656 AA).
- 2. Abraham's vision moved him to leave all to serve God.
- 3. Moses' burning bush encounter altered the course of two nations.
 - **A. DEUT. 34:5** "Servant of Jehovah" was the highest title of tribute in the Old Testament.
- **4.** Isaiah's encounter brought clarity, conviction, cleansing and commission, and moved him to serve God.
- 5. Saul of Tarsus went from being an enemy to a servant of Christ, ROM.1:1. He mentions his encounter 20 years later in ACTS 26.
- **6.** 120 in the Upper Room encountered God and were moved to serve God in a hostile environment even if it meant death.

Isaiah's Encounter IS. 6

An encounter involves God revealing Himself, communicating His plans, giving specific instructions, or imparting His wisdom to someone.

- **1.** Clarity **(V 3)** He saw an attribute of God (Holiness).
- **2.** Conviction **(V 5)** Isaiah's unclean lips, Moses' speech impediment, Saul was a murderer. God's holiness exposes our sins, inadequacies or hangups.
- 3. Cleansing (V 6-7) God deals with our sins, inadequacies or hang ups.
- 4. Commission (V 8-9) He authorizes us to carry out a duty.

Conclusion

We can't make God give us a special encounter, but we can position ourselves to experience an encounter with God by:

- 1. Seeking God (JER. 29:13).
- 2. Surrendering our will (MK. 14:36).
- 3. Be transparent (PS. 32:1-8).
- 4. Get quiet (PS. 46:10).
- 5. Stand against doubtful thoughts (PS. 3:1-5).
- 6. Remind God of His promises (JER. 33:3).
- 7. Sacrifice praise continually (HEB. 13:15).
