

POWER FROM ON HIGH

DECEMBER 10, 2025

LUKE 24:44-49

Before experiencing the joy of the Resurrection, the disciples were in deep despair. They lost sight of power from on high. Jesus brought it, modeled it, and demonstrated what it could do.

- Power from on high walked the shores of Galilee and streets of Jerusalem. The blind saw, deaf heard, crippled walked, lepers cleansed, dead raised and demons were cast out.
- Peter was so moved to experience it, he left the boat to walk on water. When his focus shifted from divine power to physical power, he began to sink.

ACTS 1:8

The fact that Jesus commanded them to wait for power from on high signifies that ministry isn't about human ability, but divine power or enablement that comes from the spirit.

- Endued means covered, clothed, and fully equipped by the Spirit.
- The core purpose is to effectively witness for Christ.
- It also enables us to overcome fear, doubt, and the mountain of obstacles the enemy hurls our way.

ZECH. 4:6-7

At the time this was spoken, Haggai and Zechariah were both ministering. Haggai encouraged the returned Jewish exiles in their work of rebuilding the temple. Zechariah's message was to repent of sin and renew their covenant with God.

- God's work isn't done through human strength, wealth, or power, but through the Spirit's divine enablement.
- Impossible obstacles are overcome by grace, not human might.

CONCLUSION: God doesn't want us to be discouraged by human limitations or afraid of earthly obstacles. What He calls us to do, His Spirit will equip us to do, by pouring into our lives all we need to succeed.
