Charles Spurgeon said “When Jesus comes, He will look for precious faith. He has more regard for faith than for all else on earth. This is the jewel for which He is searching”. Peter agrees, **2 PET. 1:1**. Spurgeon went on to say “He’s bringing a search warrant to search our hearts to determine if we honored Him by trusting His Word and His Blood. The fact that Jesus will seek for faith should cause us to think very highly of faith”.

The Hall of Faith HEB. 11

- **V1** – Defines faith as perceiving as fact what is not revealed to our senses. It’s being certain of what we don’t see.
- **V3** – The visible originated from the invisible. Faith explains creation.
- **V6** – Faith is required to please God and gain His approval.

Characteristics

- **V5** - Faith acts: Noah built an ark even though rain was never seen.
- **V8** – Faith obeys: Abraham left all, offered Isaac, **V17**.
- **V23** - Faith doesn’t fear the King: Parents of Moses.
- **V24-29** – Faith endures, chooses, and esteems: Life of Moses.
- **V31** – Faith transforms: Rahab’s life was changed.
- **V32-38** – Faith overcomes: Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, Samuel, the prophets and others.
- **V39-40** - Faith obtains a good report: Everyone who lives by faith.

Conclusion

The just shall live by faith. Our call is to walk by faith, not sight. We are to trust God above sense evidences and show God we trust His Word and integrity above all else. To God, our faith is precious. Will He find faith in us when He comes?
