HEB. 10:14-25

We are children of the Most High. Washed in the Blood Of Jesus. Delivered from the powers of darkness and brought out from the curse of poverty, sickness, and death. EX. 23:25-27

The land is where we serve Him, and He:

- Blesses our bread and water, removes sickness, protects us from miscarriages, infertility, the enemy, and fulfills our days.

IS. 1:19-20

There are conditions to be met:

- **V 19** – There's a connection between our attitudes and actions toward God's commands. Being willing and obedient results in blessings. We submit our heart and actions to Him.
- **V 20** – To ignore God's commands leads to judgment and separates us from God's protection and blessings. Judah was being warned about the consequences of rebellion and disobedience.
- The choice is ours: life and prosperity or judgment and destruction.

NUM. 14:8-9

Satan used fear to cause unbelief and rebellion, which opened the door to failure and defeat.

- Fear is a spiritual force, as is faith.
- Fear binds us to what we're afraid of (Job).
- Fear comes from evil reports, faith comes from God's report.
- Fear is confidence in the enemies ability, faith is in God's ability.
- Fear creates mountains, faith removes them.
- Fear keeps failure flowing, faith keeps victory flowing.
- Fear is expressed in word and deed, faith is also.

PS. 34:1-4

As we praise and bless God at all times, and boast on Him and all His works, He delivers us from all our fears.
