A. “Boldly” means with confidence we speak our mind and tell Him what’s on our hearts. Our access is based on the merits of Jesus.

“Obtain” means to make it our own or take it and receive it, **1 TIM. 6:12.**

“Find” means to experience, discover or encounter something after intense research. This can be for ourselves or someone else in need of healing, deliverance, or a breakthrough.

“Help in time of need” the expression comes from a military mentality. You hear your fellow soldier is in need of help, so you move quickly to fight for his well-being. The help we need comes from Jesus who hears our cry for help and goes into battle for us to be our defense and present help.
