

# RECEIVING HEALING

## INTRO: MT. 9:28-30

If we study the healing ministry of Jesus, a recurring pattern emerges. Jesus looked to see if the sick person had any faith to receive healing. We see the same pattern in Paul's ministry, **ACTS 14:8-10**. It's important that we grow in faith in order to cooperate with God for our healing. **JAMES 1:5-8**.

### Growing In Faith

1. Studying God's Word on healing, **ROM. 10:17**. Look up verses, and study anointed books on the subject. F.F. Bosworth's book, *Christ the Healer*, is one of many.
2. Looking to Jesus as our source for healing, **ACTS 9:34**. Peter directed the man's focus upon Jesus. **LUKE 6:19**, **MK. 5:27-29**.
3. Knowing healing is God's will. **MT. 8:1-3** This was before the Cross. On the Cross, Jesus clearly established healing as God's will **PS. 103:2-3**. The benefits package includes healing and forgiveness.
4. Knowing Jesus bore the curse for us, **GAL. 3:13-14**. **DEUT. 28:58-61 NLT** Be it known or unknown, named, or unnamed, written, or unwritten, Jesus redeemed us from it.
5. Understanding God's compassion, **PS. 145:8-9 NLT**. Jesus came to reveal the Father's compassionate heart, **MT. 14:14**. Compassion is being sympathetic toward the suffering of another coupled with a yearning desire to alleviate it.
6. Knowing no situation is beyond God's power, **MT. 15:29-31**. Also, **MT. 4:23-24**.

**CONCLUSION: HEB. 13:8** God has never changed. Jesus is always the same. What He did on Earth, He does today. Let's be encouraged to grow our faith and position ourselves to receive God's healing touch.
