God created us for His glory. We exist to glorify God in all we do-1  
**COR. 10:31.** How can we give glory to the King of Glory? **PS. 24:10** The Lord of Hosts is the King of Glory.  
**JOHN 1:14** Jesus manifested God's Glory. **ACTS 7:55** Stephen acknowledged God's Glory. How can we give God glory? We can't add to it. What we can do is glorify God by recognizing who He really is and responding appropriately. The Word for Glory means weighty or heavy in weight. His Glory is the weighty importance that accompanies His presence.

**Ways to Glorify God**

1. With our lips - **PS. 63:1-3 NIV.** No wonder David wanted a guard for his mouth and lips, **PS. 141:3. PR. 13:3 AMPC** Our mouths and lips can glorify God or bring ruin and destruction. **PS. 50:23**
2. Obeying God's Word – **MAL. 2:2** They presented defiled food on the altar and didn't glorify God. Obedience protects the Glory.
3. By using our authority in Jesus' Name - **JOHN 14:13, ACTS 4:21-22.**
4. By seeking the good of others - **1 COR. 10:24-31 NLT** By putting others above ourselves, we glorify God and protect His Glory among us, **JOHN 17:21-22.**
5. By bearing spiritual fruit - **JOHN 15:8.**
6. By moral purity – **1 COR. 6:18-20.**
7. By being salt and light - **MT. 5:13-16.**
8. By suffering reproach faithfully - **1 PET. 4:12-14.**
9. By giving to those in need - **2 COR. 9:13 NLT**
