2 CHRON. 7:1-3

Solomon prayed, the Fire fell, sacrifices were consumed, and the Glory filled the house. David brought the presence, power, blessings and Glory to Jerusalem (Ark). How? The Word, reverence for the sacred and the sanctification.

2 CHRON. 6: Solomon's dedicatory prayer

V1 – He said what God Said

V4 – He blessed God for keeping His Word

V5-11 – He explains God's plan and how he fulfilled it

V12-14 – His prayer exalts God, reminds Him of the covenant, speaks of His mercy and emphasizes heartfelt obedience

V15 – He credits Jehovah for building the temple and acknowledges how God kept His promises

V16 – He reminds God of another promise that He made

V17 – Verify means to confirm or prove to be true

V18 – He flatters God with this saying

V19-21 – He asks God to respect His people's prayers, and to forgive them

V22-39 – Hear, maintain their cause, and forgive them

V40-42 – Peter says the same, I Peter 3:12
