INTRO: LEV. 9:5-7, 23-24

These verses reveal the law of divine cooperation. Moses did his part, then God did His part. The glory appeared, the fire came out, and the sacrifices were consumed. Then in **LEV. 10:1-3**, we have verses that reveal what happens when man does things apart from God's instructions. It can be deadly! The same is true with electricity and fire.

BELIEF AND MOTIVATION:

1. The Jewish Sacrifice: The belief is that sacrifices are necessary to please God and obtain His forgiveness, favor and blessings.
2. The Olympian: The belief is to sacrifice one's childhood, and one's time with family and friends, will one day earn a gold medal.
3. The Believer: The belief is to sacrifice one's lower life for Christ; one can obtain a higher life that ends in being clothed in glory.
 - a. **ROM. 12:1-2 KJV, MSG**
 - b. **I COR. 9:24-27 MSG** – like the Olympian, the one believes his sacrifice pleases God and positions him to experience God's favor, blessings and forgiveness. So, he surrenders his eyes to only look upon what is holy, his ears to hear righteous words, his hands to perform righteous deeds, and lips to speak right words, **PR. 23:15-16**.

COLLECTIVELY:

1. **2 CHRON. 7:1-3** – Every believer is a priceless jewel who plays a unique role in carrying out God's plan. When we gather together and do our part, we create a habitation for God to manifest His glory and perform signs, wonders, and miracles among us. **2 CHRON. 5:11-14**.
2. **HEB. 13:15** – By sacrificing our body in consecration to God and offering the sacrifices of praise to Him by Jesus Christ, we position ourselves to experience a richer, fuller, and higher life in God.

CONCLUSION:

God has done his part in giving us Jesus. Our part is to sacrifice praise to God continually, so the fire can fall and the glory fill the house of God.
